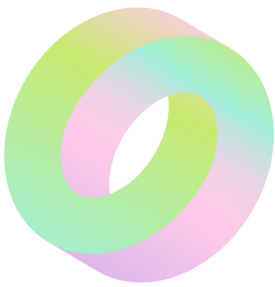

- Understanding.

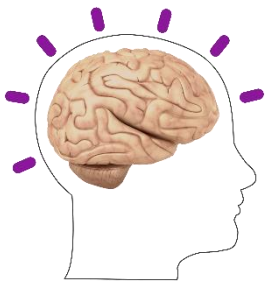


This will help them to learn how to work better for Autistic and autism communities.

The South Australian Government want to remove **barriers** to:



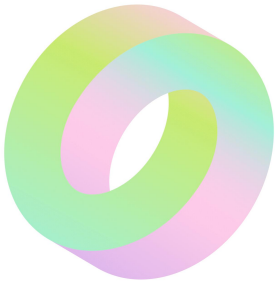
- Education.
